BOROUGH OF BROWNSVILLE EMERGENCY DECLARATION

This Emergency Declaration issued by the Mayor, is to establish an understanding for the stakeholders of the Borough of Brownsville, the County of Fayette, and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The Emergency is caused by the demolition of 39-41 Market Street (Tax Parcel ID #02-06-0145), which will result in the necessary demolition of the attached buildings located at 35 Market Street (Tax Parcel ID #02-06-0144) and 43 Market Street (Tax Parcel ID #02-06-0146) which are both located on the main throughway of Brownsville, known as Market Street, and which has caused imminent danger of failure or collapse of a building or structure which endangers life.

Whereas, the owner of the property has been notified of this imminent danger. Said owner has 72 hours to remedy the matter, or be subject to fines and fees each day thereafter. If said owner does not remedy the situation within such time frame, the Borough of Brownsville can then exercise its rights under the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to demolish said property, and defer the related costs back to the property owner.

Additionally, the following roads have been closed and fire and rescue services have been rerouted:

- North Market Street will be closed at Albany Road
- South Market Street will be closed at Bank Street
- Market Street will be closed at Brownsville Avenue
- Market Street will be closed at Brown Street

We are declaring this Emergency to establish assistance for the safety and security of the Borough residents and general public.
