**A RESOLUTION OF BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BROWNSVILLE, FAYETTE
COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, TO JOIN THE MON RIVER TOWNS
PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Mon River Towns Program (MRTP), an initiative of the National Road Heritage Corridor (NRHC), was created to help communities along the Monongahela River diversify their local economies, enhance their quality of life, and implement initiatives that strengthen their future sustainability and resilience; and

WHEREAS, the MRTP aims to bring together local officials and stakeholders as part of a regional approach that provides river town communities with greater opportunities to attract visitors and business investment related to the growing outdoor recreation and tourism markets; and

WHEREAS, through the implementation of projects and initiatives, the MRTP will support the preservation of the Mon Valley's natural and historic assets and work with environmental organizations to protect and enhance the river ecosystem; and

WHEREAS, the MRTP will provide river town communities with an opportunity to develop and leverage collaborations and partnerships through their participation in the Mon River Valley Coalition; and

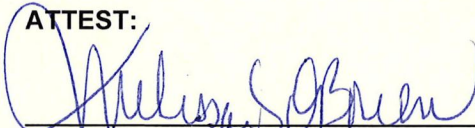
WHEREAS, participation in the MRTP may help in enhancing the activities and development of these communities; and

WHEREAS, membership in the MRTP is voluntary and will not result in a financial obligation of the Borough of Brownsville; and

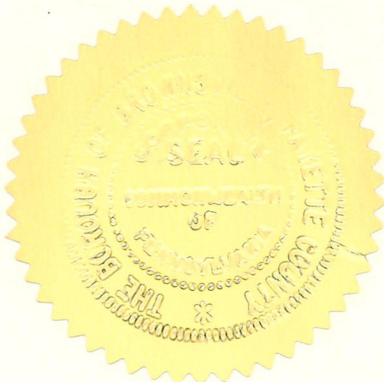

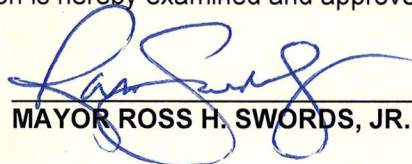
