RESOLUTION NO. R-04-2024

A SECOND RESOLUTION OF BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BROWNSVILLE, FAYETTE COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY SEALED BID OF BOROUGH-OWNED PROPERTY IDENTIFIED AS A 2009 FORD F-550.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Brownsville owns title to a 2009 Ford F-550;

WHEREAS, Council estimates the fair market value of the 2009 Ford F-550 to be \$21,000.00;

WHEREAS, Section 1201.2(a) of the Borough Code, sets forth the requirements for the sale of Borough owned personal property, including but not limited to, authorization of such sale by resolution of Council. See 8 Pa. C.S. § 1201.2(a);

WHEREAS, Council adopted Resolution R-02-2024, during the regular Council Meeting on May 8, 2024, authorizing the sale of the Property by sealed bid, and no sealed bids were received by the deadline on June 7, 2024 at 12:00PM;

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Borough to sell the Property by sealed bid, and desires to accomplish the same pursuant to the Borough Code;

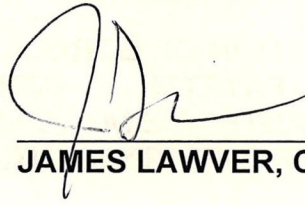
WHEREAS, Section 1641.1(b) of the Municipal Property Purchase and Sale Law, sets forth the requirements for the sale of Borough owned property when no bids are received, including but not limited to a second advertisement and the right of proper officials to negotiate where a second round of bidding is unsuccessful. See 73 P.S. § 1641.1(b).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Borough Council of the Borough of Brownsville authorizes the sale of its used, 2009 Ford-550, with a reserve price of \$21,000.00. This sale of the personal property shall be conducted by sealed bid, where bids will be accepted until 07/08/2024, with a deadline of submission being 12:00PM on 07/08/2024. All bids will be opened by Council President during the 07/10/2024 regular monthly meeting. The proper officers of the Borough are authorized to re-advertise notice soliciting bids on this personal property, at least fifteen (15) days prior to the opening of bids, and in accordance with all requirements of the Borough Code, and applicable Pennsylvania law. The proper officers of the Borough are further authorized to complete all appropriate measures to accomplish the transaction, including but not limited to awarding the bid to the best responsible bidder. The best responsible bidder shall tender a certified check no later than ten (10) days after bids have been opened. Should the best responsible bidder fail to do so, the bid shall be awarded to the next best responsible bidder. Should no bids be received by the 07/08/2024 deadline, the proper officers of the Borough are further authorized to initiate negotiations for a private sale of the property, at a value not less than the \$21,000.00 reserve price.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately.

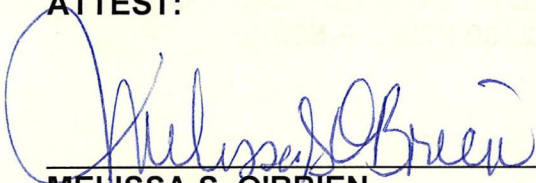

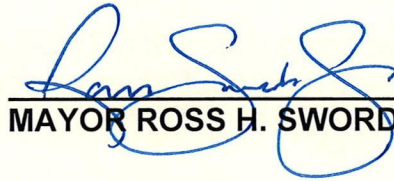
