**A RESOLUTION OF BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF BROWNSVILLE,
FAYETTE COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE
SALE BY SEALED BID OF BOROUGH-OWNED PROPERTY IDENTIFIED AS A 2009
FORD F-550**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Brownsville owns title to a 2009 Ford F-550;

WHEREAS, Council estimates the fair market value of the 2009 Ford F-550 to be \$21,000.00.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Borough to sell the Property by sealed bid, and desires to accomplish the same pursuant to the Borough Code;

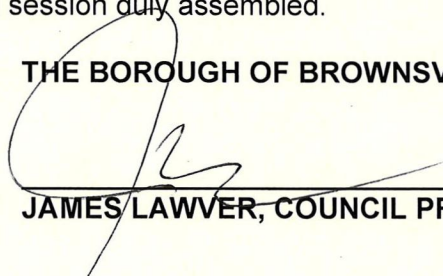
WHEREAS, Section 1201.2(a) of the Borough Code, sets forth the requirements for the sale of Borough owned personal property, including but not limited to, authorization of such sale by resolution of Council. See 8 Pa. C.S. § 1201.2(a);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Borough Council of the Borough of Brownsville authorizes the sale of its used, 2009 Ford-550, with a reserve price of \$21,000.00. This sale of the personal property shall be conducted by sealed bid, where bids will be accepted between May 13, 2024 and June 7, 2024, with a deadline of submission being 12:00 p.m. on June 7, 2024. All bids will be opened on June 12, 2024 by Council President during the regular monthly meeting. The proper officers of the Borough are authorized to advertise notice soliciting bids on this personal property, at least ten (10) days prior to the opening of bids, and in accordance with all requirements of the Borough Code. The proper officers of the Borough are further authorized to complete all appropriate measures to accomplish the transaction, including but not limited to awarding the bid to the best responsible bidder. The best responsible bidder shall tender a certified check no later than ten (10) days after bids have been opened. Should the best responsible bidder fail to do so, the bid shall be awarded to the next best responsible bidder.

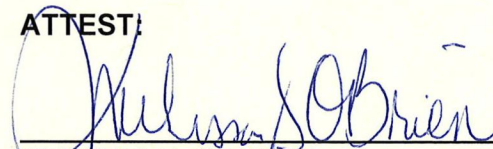
This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately.

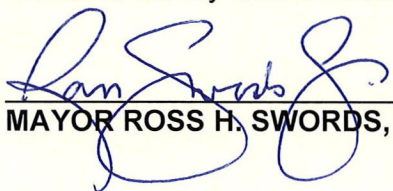
